



Starting **March 29, 2026**, Iberia will launch a new **daily flight** between **Madrid and Newark Liberty International Airport**. This route **complements** the **two daily flights** the airline already operates to **John F. Kennedy International Airport**.

Newark is a strategic addition that offers convenient access to Manhattan, giving travelers more choices and enhancing the experience for both leisure and business customers. During the summer season, this expansion will increase capacity between Madrid and New York by 40%.

The route will be operated by the Airbus **A321XLR**—an aircraft Iberia was the launch customer for and the most efficient in our fleet for transatlantic flights. This single-aisle aircraft delivers a premium experience with the new Airspace cabin, LED lighting, and two classes: Business and Economy.

Iberia en the United Estates

Iberia offers **ten destinations** in the **United States** and is consolidating its commitment to the North American market with the addition of a daily flight to Newark.

During **2025**, Iberia will offer nearly 2 million seats between Spain and the United States and an average of **150 flights per week**. For this winter season, the Spanish airline will operate

two daily flights to New York and Miami; up to two daily flights to Boston and Puerto Rico, routes that have been reinforced thanks to the arrival of the Airbus A321XLR; and **three weekly flights to Washington**, which has gone from being an exclusively summer route to operating year-round. The **daily flight to Chicago**, the **four weekly flights to Dallas Fort Worth and Orlando**, and the **three flights to Los Angeles** will also continue. **San Francisco** is operated as a summer route with **three weekly flights from May to September**.

This network of direct flights, together with Iberia's joint business agreement for North Atlantic routes with **American Airlines, British Airways and Finnair**, enables it to offer robust connectivity, **400 destinations** in more than 100 countries, and diversified coverage in the United States.
