Cathay's possible buy back of all of Qatar Airways' shareholding in Cathay

Cathay Pacific Airways Limited ("Cathay") and Qatar Airways Q.C.S.C ("Qatar Airways") announced that Qatar Airways has entered into an undertaking in favour of Cathay to execute a buy-back agreement pursuant to which Cathay will buy back all of Qatar Airways' shareholding in Cathay. Qatar Airways' shareholding in Cathay represents approximately 9.57% of the total issued shares of Cathay. The total consideration for the buy-back is HK\$6,969,273,804.
