



## Manchester update 09JAN26

Dear Trade Partner,

Given the uncertainty regarding the Manchester transatlantic flights, we are revising our commercial policy to help mitigate that uncertainty.

As part of this, Aer Lingus is no longer selling transatlantic flights to/from Manchester for travel from 31 March 2026. There is no impact on Aer Lingus or Aer Lingus Regional flights between Manchester and Ireland.

Customers already booked on Aer Lingus UK transatlantic services from Manchester from 31 March onwards:

- Re-accommodation options on **EI only** over DUB waiver code **RI26MAN**
- Lowest RBD, same cabin applies
- Waiver code apply to EI 053 ticket stock only
- Rebooking of un ticketed on EI metal, please ensure original fare stored

Or

- Refund using waiver code RF26MAN

For impacted bookings issued by partner airlines, please contact issuing carrier for re-protection policy.

Any future changes to our schedule will be communicated through the normal GDS messaging process. However, given the uncertainty, we make the re-protection option available now.

We appreciate our customers' patience and cooperation during this time.
