Dear Travel Agents,

A new way to travel with TAP: more space, more privacy, and greater comfort.

TAP introduces **Economy Prime**, the new product positioned between Economy and Business, offering a superior experience both at the airport and onboard. This new cabin will be available on the A330-200, A330-900neo, and A321LR, on almost all long-haul routes*.

Designed to enhance your Customers' travel experience, Economy Prime combines more space, more privacy, and greater comfort, with exclusive benefits that make a difference at every stage of the journey. From the moment they arrive at the airport through landing, passengers will enjoy a superior experience within the Economy offering.

Reservations will be available starting **March 31, 2026**, for travel beginning **June 1, 2026** — an excellent opportunity to offer your Customers a new way to travel on TAP's long-haul flights.

What services are included in both brands of this new cabin?

Before the day of travel:

- Baggage allowance: 1 carry-on bag up to 10 kg + 2 checked bags of 23 kg each
- Seat selection: Complimentary seat selection at any time
- Seating configuration where the passenger has an adjacent empty seat in the first 3 rows (empty side seat), providing greater privacy and additional space

At the airport:

- Premium Check-in
- Fast-track security: Priority access at selected airports
- Priority baggage
- Priority boarding

Onboard:

- Catering service: Premium main meal (same as Business Class) with two hot meal options; the second meal will be the Economy Class service
- Meal pre-selection: Ability to choose meals in advance (up to 24 hours before departure)
- Amenities: Amenity kit and Premium pillow

In connection with the new cabin, three specific booking classes will be used: **W, S, and K** for long-haul (intercontinental) flights.

Whenever it is necessary to book the new Brands on itineraries connecting with routes where **ECONOMY PRIME** is not available (for example, CCS–LIS–FNC), please use the following booking classes:

W Class fares: Flights without Economy Prime should preferably be booked in classes Q/H/M/B, and if these RBDs are unavailable, use class Y.

S Class fares: Flights without Economy Prime should preferably be booked in classes Q/H, and if these RBDs are unavailable, use class M.

K Class fares: Flights without Economy Prime should preferably be booked in class Q, and if this RBD is unavailable, use class H.
