COMMUNICATION

D. PUNCTUALITY:

Beyond professionalism, punctuality is paramount for your wedding entertainment. Their on-time arrival and adherence to schedule are crucial for a smooth event flow, allowing you and your planner to manage the evening seamlessly. Crucially, if your ceremony and reception are at the same location, the band must be fully set up and sound-checked before guest arrival, ensuring your processional isn't interrupted and your special moments remain undisturbed.

FLEXIBILITY:

Wedding plans often shift unexpectedly, from impromptu speeches to extended photo sessions or even spontaneous performances. An experienced wedding band, however, will embrace these changes with skill, grace, and a positive attitude. Their ability to adapt seamlessly ensures your day remains flawless, leaving you with wonderful, stress-free memories.

- 5. Is there any additional equipment I have to provide?
- 6. Do you have your own sound engineer to ensure my event sounds great?
- 7. Will you learn any special song requests for my event? If so, how many?
- 8. What happens if I ask you to play longer or shorter than the previously agreed amount length of time on the day of the event?
- 9. How long are your sets and set breaks? Will you have music to play during your breaks to keep the guests energy and mood up?
