Ann Martini

Ann Martini is a child, adolescent and adult psychoanalyst. She is on the faculty of the San Francisco Center for Psychoanalysis where she is a personal and consulting analyst, and was a founding member of the Palo Alto Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy Training Program in which she is a member of the Guidance Committee.

She is in private practice in Campbell, California where she specializes in work with young children and their parents, but sees patients across the lifespan.

In addition to leading the Child and Adult Case Conference at San Francisco Center for Psychoanalysis for many years, she has run a private consultation group for therapists working with children and adolescents for 15 years. She is also a past member of the IPA Committee on Child and Adolescent Psychoanalysis.



Mary Brady

Dr. Mary Brady is an adult and child psychoanalyst in San Francisco. On the Faculties of the San Francisco Center for Psychoanalysis and the Psychoanalytic Institute of Northern California, she is recipient of the American Psychoanalytic Association's Roughton Paper Award.

Her book, *Psychoanalysis with Adolescents and Children: Learning to Surf* has recently been published by Routledge. She is Editor of *Braving the Erotic Field in the Treatment of Children and Adolescents*, author of *Analytic Engagements with Adolescents* and *The Body in Adolescence* (Routledge 2022, 2018 and 2016 respectively).

She is Co-Chair of the Committee on the Status of Women and Girls for APsA and former Co-Chair of the Committee of Child and Adolescent Psychoanalysis for the IPA. For a decade she has co-led a *Psychoanalysis and Film* group.
