


MTH RICHMOND & DANVILLE 4-4-0 & 64' WOODSIDE SET



The Richmond & Danville railroad was a railroad which operated independently from 1847 to 1894 and the first in the U.S. state of Virginia. A 140 mile stretch, it was a vital link between the Confederate capital of Richmond and the rest of the Confederacy.

The 64' woodside period cars are named for the cities along that 140 mile route.

In 1894 it was conveyed into the new Southern Railway.
