

# **Q4 Disposable Glove Market Update**

October 2025



#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The U.S. disposable glove market is navigating a complex landscape shaped by aggressive tariff policies, volatile domestic logistics costs, resilient demand, and a shifting economic backdrop. Despite rising prices and other economic headwinds, the market remains fundamentally strong, driven by consistent demand and growth across glove use cases and applications. In this dynamic market environment, AMMEX continues to support clients with 98%+ fill rates, quality, compliance, and service.

## **OVERVIEW OF 2025 TARIFF POLICY**

By the end of Q3 2025, the U.S. government implemented sweeping tariffs on disposable gloves, particularly targeting imports from China. As a result, all countries that produce disposable gloves face tariffs ranging from 19% to 80%, with tariffs on Chinese gloves set to increase by an additional 50% on January 1, 2026.

### MANUFACTURING CAPACITY

Malaysia and Thailand continue to dominate global glove production, accounting for up to 70% of global supply. Factories in several other countries, notably Vietnam and Indonesia, have also invested in scaling glove production. Global disposable glove production in 2025 is at an all-time high, with over 350 billion gloves.

Domestic glove production remains limited, and U.S.-made gloves still represent a small fraction of the total market supply, with limited prospects for growth despite growing tariffs on foreign-made disposable gloves.



Challenges for domestic manufacturers are not new and include high input costs due to imported raw materials, limited scalability compared to Southeast Asian factories, regulatory hurdles, and slower ramp-up timelines.



#### LOGISTICS & SHIPPING COSTS

Shipping lanes from Southeast Asia to the U.S. West Coast continue to face congestion. Average transit times have been relatively high. Peak season surcharges have made a fleeting appearance, but the overall logistical landscape continues to be dynamic due to several factors, such as geopolitical tensions, occurrences of container shortages, and uneven global trade recovery.

The U.S. freight costs are also increasing due to labor shortages in trucking, increased demand for expedited delivery, and higher insurance and compliance costs.





## **DEMAND TRENDS AND Q4 2025 OUTLOOK**

As we move into Q4, the disposable glove market will continue to face upward pricing pressure from tariffs as well as increased domestic logistics and operational costs.

Despite these challenges, the disposable glove market in North America remains resilient. Demand across all applications, from the medical facilities and industrial sectors to personal care and hygiene, continues to be strong.

Strategic sourcing, operational efficiency, and proactive planning will be key to navigating the months ahead.
