Running the Race Before Us

Following in the wake of the Paris Olympics, I am reminded of what Hebrews 12:1-2 has to say to all of us in carrying Christ to everyhome, everywhere and every generation and thereby fulfilling the Great Commission.

The Hebrews verse says:

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God....

Hebrews 12:1 uses the metaphor of a long-distance race to encapsulate the Christian journey. It emphasises the importance of learning from the faith-filled past, shedding hindrances and running with endurance on the unique path that God has marked out for each of us and of course EHC. The author has in view a marathon rather than a sprint, as seen in the phrase "with endurance" and

so Hebrews 12 reminds us that we are not alone in our spiritual journey and invites us to embrace God's loving discipline, live a holy life and keep our focus on Jesus.

As I write this message, I am witnessing in the news so many challenges EHC faces in our humanitarian support. Countries like Cameroon, New Guinea, Ethiopia, Bangladesh and Israel are all in need of financial and spiritual support. Biblically, James reminds us that trials serve to strengthen our faith and bring us to maturity (James 1:2-3) so Hebrews 12:1 is reminding us to persevere through those trials, knowing that, by God's faithfulness, we won't be overwhelmed by them (1 Corinthians 10:13).

My personal 'thank you' for your continued prayers and support.




Samoa Needs Your Support


Celebrating Fathers and Supporting the Zambia Farming Project

Please Pray for Bangladesh

Background

Bangladesh is currently experiencing significant political and social unrest following the resignation of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on August 5, 2024. This development occurred after weeks of widespread protests, primarily led by students, which resulted in numerous casualties and widespread chaos. The abrupt transition to an interim government has exacerbated tensions, raising concerns about the rise of fundamental radicalism, particularly with the involvement of the banned Islamic party, Jamaat.

Impact on Christian Communities

The situation has become increasingly dangerous for minority groups, including Christians and Hindus. According to the National Director for Bangladesh Every Home for Christ, several Christian organizations, churches and homes have been targeted in a wave of violence. Many pastors and evangelists, who play a crucial role in community support and outreach, have been forced into hiding or compelled to flee due to

direct threats and attacks.

The escalation of violence has led to significant destruction of property and the safety of ministry workers and their families remains a primary concern. Churches have been vandalized and the overall atmosphere is one of fear and uncertainty.

Action Taken

Every Home for Christ Bangladesh is closely coordinating with military authorities to ensure the safety of its workers. Precautionary measures have been implemented and pastors have been advised to remain vigilant.

Prayer Request

In light of these events, we urgently request prayers for:

- Peace and stability in Bangladesh.
- Protection and strength for our ministry workers, pastors and their families.
- Safety for all minority groups affected by the violence.
- Wisdom for leaders overseeing the transitional government.

Your prayers and support are crucial as we navigate this challenging situation.



Holistic Discipleship: Reaching South Asian Peoples for Jesus

People from India now make up the group with the highest migration numbers into Australia, overtaking China. In fact, if we include the broader category of South Asia (India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh and Nepal) and take into account the majority religions of those regions (Hinduism, Islam, Buddhism, Jainism, Baha'ism, Sikhism, etc) - it is clear that followers of Jesus need to consider how best to take up the opportunity to preach the gospel to this people group. Are we ready to get alongside people who desperately need assurance and stability that comes only in a relationship with God through Jesus Christ his Son?

The SATYA group invites you to come along to our annual conference. SATYA stands for South Asian Tide for Yesu in Australia. And that is our prayer and hope, that we might see a tide of South Asian people come to have a saving faith in Jesus.

The first letter of John says, 'Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.' For all people but culturally perhaps even more so for South Asian friends, it is

important for us to not only share the gospel with words but show the power of the gospel in our lives by the way we love.'

That's why our SATYA Conference this year is on 'Holistic Discipleship'. We'd love to see you there, as we learn from and encourage each other in this important work.

CREATIVE ACCESS - SOUTH ASIA Tensions between religious factions is increasing day by day in this nation. Unfortunately, this means that many churches here are under threat. IRELAND/NORTHERN **IRELAND** Pop. 5,255,017 Map **91** We are delivering 1,000 Gospels of Mark to a partner church in the upcoming days. Our prayer is that people read God's Word, it would speak to their hearts and they would come to know Jesus. Psalm 64 (Hosea 8-13)

 Christ known to their neighbours. Pray for
 continued grace. Psalm 75 (Jeremiah 11-12)
- 192 The leadership of Every Home in Dominica requests prayer that many in their nation would come to Jesus Christ. They also request that believers will become more sensitive to the Holy Spirit and obey the Lord's commands, especially as they relate to reaching others with the gospel. Psalm 76 (Jeremiah 26, 7-10)

RUSSIA Pop. 144,820,423 Map 106 Our team went on a trip to villages where there are no churches at all. We were amazed how people were listening attentively, as if they were hearing about God for the first time. Pray for these communities, that many would come to know Jesus and a church would be established. Psalm 77 (Jeremiah 14-20)

PHILIPPINES Pop. 115,843,670
Map 169 We praise God for his protection of the Every Home team that recently visited the island of Masbate and the province of Sorsogon. The team met with pastors who may partner in the house-to-house evangelistic work. Pray that this effort would result in many partnerships and that pastors would be excited to partner with Every Home. Psalm 78 (Jeremiah 35-36)

25 CREATIVE ACCESS - MIDDLE EAST We request prayer for God to give the ministry in this nation more people to help in the work. Pray that the Lord Jesus' name would be glorified in this nation for years to come and that no obstacle would hinder the work. Psalm 79 (Jeremiah 45,25)

50UTH AFRICA Pop.
64,007,187 Map 1 Pray for the anointing of the Holy Spirit and the tangible presence of God during upcoming prayer meetings and outreach events. Pray for a revival in Petrusburg as people encounter the love and power of God. Psalm 80 (Jeremiah 46-49)

VENEZUELA Pop. 28,405,543 Map 214 Pray for the teams in Venezuela. They will be in different places around the country giving large-scale evangelism trainings to groups of churches. Pray that God would give them the best strategies, so that they can provide churches with all the preparation they need to develop their evangelistic work. **Psalm 81 (Jeremiah 13,22-23)**

CREATIVE ACCESS - SOUTH ASIA Several young people are taking part in outreaches with Every Home in the southern part of the country. The high temperature and rainfall are unpredictable in this region. Pray for good weather, health and protection for all the participants. Believers need to be strong as people practise witchcraft here. **Psalm 82** (Jeremiah 24,27-29)

NORTH MACEDONIA Pop. 1,823,009 Map 74 With elections coming up this year, please pray for justice to rule and for good leadership for their country. Pray that people would not put all their hope in human leaders but rather that they would seek Jesus. Pray for God's will to be done in the election. Psalm 83 (Jeremiah 50-51)

CYPRUS Pop. 1,358,282 Map 113 Pray for a couple from Israel that our Every Home team is following up with on a weekly basis. Pray for God's work in their hearts. Pray for our team, volunteers and the church partners who are going daily to preach the gospel around the island. Psalm 84 (Jeremiah 30-33)
