Recently I had the pleasure of preaching to around 70 Pastors in South East Asia on three separate days at which the pilot project known as 'Love Your Neighbor' (LYN) was launched.

(Colorado USA) to inspire and equip everyday believers to carry Christ's love into their neighbourhoods, work places

The soon to be released 'Love Your **Neighbor'** kit will be released globally which is an initiative from Every Home

Christian faith. They are seen as the essence of what it means to live a life that pleases God and reflects His love for humanity.

This kit offers more than just resources, it extends an invitation to look beyond ourselves, to draw closer to one another and ultimately, to draw nearer to lesus. Our walk with Christ is both a personal journey and a public expression. To fully live out our purpose, both dimensions must be embraced. As our love

for God deepens, so does our ability to love those around us.

"Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another" (1 John 4:11)

Our world is facing a crisis of disconnection, marked by loneliness, anxiety and division. The Love Your Neighbor initiative is a timely response,

In preparing my sermons it became clear that I needed to revisit the two greatest commandments which, according to Matthew 22:37-39 lesus says, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind'. This first and the greatest commandment. And the second

is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself,'" There is nothing more important than knowing God and making his love known.

commandments These considered the foundation of all other laws and teachings.

Moreover, these two commandments are intrinsically linked and are considered the most important principles of the



equipping churches with tools to foster spiritual formation, genuine community and relational outreach rooted in Christ's love. Through practical resources and intentional engagement, we seek to help churches overcome barriers, meet real needs and embody witness that combines a compassionate action with the life-changing truth of the gospel.

In this issue of our EHC Newsletter. you will see that we also have a partnership with the Burmese community who have started their own LYN style program called Serve Your Neighbour Australia (SYNA). When I was preaching at the Burmese church some months ago in Sydney, it was explained to me that your financial support is being used not only to support the Earthquake victims in Burma where the devastating 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck Myanmar on 28 March 2025 with more than 3,600 people confirmed dead, over 5,000 injured and hundreds are still missing but also assisting SYNA with it's **The Greatest Light Project**, a life-changing initiative to bring solar energy to some of the most underserviced regions of Burma and surrounding refugee communities in Thailand.

Both LYN and SYNA are putting into practise the second greatest commandment which highlights the importance of treating others with the same love, respect and care that you would give yourself. This includes showing compassion, kindness and forgiveness. Both projects are entrenched in compassion and driven by intentionality, mobilising believers around the world to see people through



the eyes of Christ, show love through tangible acts of care and speak hope through the gospel.

Sharing your faith doesn't need to be complicated. Simple acts of kindness can open hearts and help others experience God's love. Jesus said: "...Love your neighbour as yourself." (Mark 12:31).

Lighting the Way

The Greatest Light Project Brings Solar Power to Remote Communities in Burma



Every Home Global Concern is proud to announce a new partnership with Serve Your Neighbour Australia (SYNA) to launch *The Greatest Light Project*, a life-changing initiative to bring solar energy to some of the most underserviced regions of Burma (Myanmar) and surrounding refugee communities in Thailand.

For over a decade, SYNA has been a beacon of compassion and practical support in Southeast Asia, operating free medical clinics, schools and humanitarian programs. This latest project, aptly named The Greatest Light, builds on that legacy by introducing sustainable energy solutions to areas without access to electricity, many of which are also home to Christian outreach ministries.



Project Overview

Project Name: The Greatest Light Project **Locations:** Suburban Yangon, Pagu Township and Sagaing Township

Duration: 12 months (phased implementation)



Why Solar Power?

Electricity is not a luxury, it's a lifeline. In these remote regions, children are studying by candlelight, clinics operate without proper lighting and entire communities are held back by lack of access to basic energy.

The Greatest Light Project will provide fifteen complete solar cell systems (each with 1,000W output, inverter and battery), bringing safe, sustainable electricity to:

- Three orphanages, giving children a stable learning and living environment.
- Three schools, where students can now study after dark and teachers can use technology in the classroom.
- Three clinics, allowing critical medical equipment to function reliably and safely.



Purpose & Impact

The initiative directly supports Every Home Global Concern & SYNA's broader mission to uplift disadvantaged communities through health, education and faith-based humanitarian efforts.

Expected Outcomes Include

- Increased school attendance and academic performance.
- Improved quality of healthcare services in medical clinics.
- Greater reach and effectiveness of Christian outreach activities.
- Local empowerment through training in solar system maintenance.

Community-Led Sustainability

One of the most empowering features of this project is its long-term sustainability model. SYNA's local teams will train local residents and volunteers to install, operate and maintain the systems.





This ensures not only long-term functionality but also builds capacity and resilience in each community served.

Overcoming Challenges

Remote terrain, limited infrastructure and communication barriers are real concerns but not insurmountable. The project incorporates a clear risk mitigation strategy, including:

- Partnering with local churches and mission workers to navigate difficult logistics.
- Providing extensive hands-on and virtual training.
- Establishing communication hubs to streamline project coordination.



A Mission Beyond Power

More than a technical solution, The Greatest Light Project is a spiritual investment. Electricity will not only light rooms, it will illuminate hearts and minds, creating spaces where the Gospel can be shared and lives transformed.

This initiative is not just about wires and watts. It's about dignity, opportunity and the light of Christ reaching the darkest corners of the world.

Prayer, Suffering and Hope

Pastor Shane Khin Leads Powerful Online Prayer Meeting for Burma

Every Home for Christ Australia recently hosted a moving online prayer meeting led by Pastor Shane Khin of the Burmese Christian Church in South Granville. The gathering, held as part of our April monthly prayer series, focused on the heartbreaking aftermath of the recent earthquake in Burma (Myanmar) and the spiritual, physical and political challenges facing the Burmese people.



A Nation in Crisis

Pastor Shane began the evening by sharing sobering updates from Burma, a nation already suffering under the weight of a civil unrest. The recent 7.8-magnitude earthquake has only deepened the crisis, devastating homes, churches and infrastructure, while ongoing conflict continues to hinder humanitarian aid.

To help contextualise the situation, Pastor Shane shared short clips from international news outlets including the BBC, Al Jazeera and NHK. These reports were shared under Australia's Fair Dealing provision of copyright law, which permits limited use of copyrighted material for the purposes of criticism and review, in the case,

to illustrate the urgent need for prayer and support. The videos showed:

- Both natural disasters and political unrest led to displacement and loss of life.
- A complete collapse of basic services, including healthcare, water, food supply and shelter.
- Religious and historical sites destroyed and traumatised citizens were living in open fields and temporary shelters.

These clips served not only to inform but to provoke deep reflection and heartfelt intercession among attendees.



Topics of Prayer

Led by Pastor Shane and others in attendance, the prayer meeting covered a range of urgent topics, including:

I. Relief for Earthquake Survivors

Prayer was offered for those injured, bereaved and displaced by the quake. The Red Cross estimates tens of thousands are still without shelter.

2. Unity Across Faiths

In a surprising and hopeful development, Christian churches, Buddhist monasteries and Muslim mosques have begun working together to support the affected. Pastor Shane encouraged continued prayer for this unity in relief efforts.

3. **Spiritual Deliverance**

Pastor Shane highlighted the deep spiritual warfare in the country. Prayers were made for spiritual awakening and sound doctrine within the church.

4. Reach of Resources

Prayers were also made for humanitarian aid to reach those who are genuinely in need.

5. Salvation for National Leaders

Special prayers were lifted up for all National Leaders in Burma who are yet to receive Jesus as their personal Saviour.



A Call to Action

As Pastor Shane poignantly noted, "We stand with the people who are suffering." His church has launched a local initiative, Serve Your Neighbour Australia (SYNA) and Every Home Global Concern has partnered with the charity to actively raise funds for relief efforts. A fundraising dinner was held on May 17 in Granville, NSW, to support direct aid to affected communities.

Despite the immense suffering, a spirit of hope and resilience was evident throughout the meeting. Several prayers



boldly declared an end to the violence, a return to peace and the lifting up of Burma into light and freedom.




