When the EHC team arrived in Coffs Harbour, this was the first glimpse of the Spirit-filled journey awaiting us. 'The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor' (Isaiah 61:1)

We have been blessed to have developed a ministry connection with **Anglican Rev. Imran Maqsood** who attended our Christmas Spectacular event last year. At his invitation, EHC organised a three-day **Outreach** event in the Coffs Harbour region where there is a strong Sikh community including many of whom are committed Christians and many still yet to come to know our Lord Jesus Christ.

Woolgoolga is home to around 430 Sikh families, approximately 1,720 people, with a further 2,000 Sikhs residing in Coffs Harbour city. 

Clean Water Brings Hope to Zambia's Villages

In rural Zambia, access to clean water remains one of the greatest daily challenges. In villages such as Ma*** and Ka***, with a combined population of 1,200, only two improved shallow wells serve the entire community. This shortfall has left many, particularly women and young girls, walking long distances, often before dawn, to fetch water.



For eight-year-old Mo*** from Ma*** Village, this means rising at 4 a.m. to carry a heavy bucket of water over 1.5 kilometres before school. The toll is heavy: exhaustion, health concerns, missed classes and exposure to dangers along the way. Her mother, Al***, worries about the risks of gender-based



violence and waterborne diseases, which frequently affect children when families resort to using unsafe ponds shared with animals.

Every Home Global Concern (EHGC), through its Zambia project staff and in partnership with village leaders, is stepping in to meet this urgent need. Teams have been rehabilitating shallow wells, ensuring they are properly constructed and safe, despite the challenge of high water levels that complicate digging and walling. These efforts are already transforming lives, bringing water closer to families and restoring health and safety to vulnerable communities. "Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water" - John 7:38

None of this would be possible without the generosity of our EHC donors. Your support has enabled wells to be built, ponds to be replaced with safe water points and children like Mo*** to dream of school rather than fear the long, dangerous walk for water.



Most recently, EHGC began construction on two new bore wells, one in Ka*** and one in Ma***. Unlike shallow wells, these deeper bore wells will provide a more reliable and sustainable water source year-round. Their arrival has created enormous joy and excitement among the villagers, who now see a future where children are no longer forced to risk their safety or health for something as basic as water.



On behalf of the families of Ma***, Ka*** and beyond, thank you for making clean water a reality. Your kindness is transforming lives in Zambia, one well at a time. "The well of water springing up into eternal life". **John 4:14**


